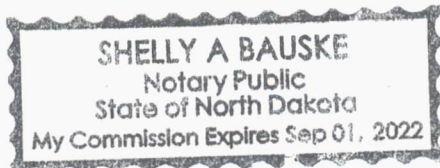

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NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND ORDER AND
NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

November 21, 2019

On October 9, 2013, the Commission issued its Order on Eligible Telecommunications Carrier Designation (Order) in case PU-13-203 designating Boomerang Wireless, LLC (Boomerang) as an eligible telecommunications carrier in all exchange areas within North Dakota.

On October 30, 2019 Boomerang filed a Motion to Partially Amend Order, requesting that the commission eliminate the requirements contained within Order point 4 in case PU-13-203.

The issue is whether the Order should be amended to remove the requirement to file annually a complete listing of lifeline customers including the type of proof reviewed, eligibility dates, and North Dakota Department of Human Services Form SFN 1059.

Comments and requests for hearing must be received by January 6, 2020. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
