Great Plains Natural Gas Co. (Case No. PU-13-551)

On October 9, 2013, the commission approved converting Great Plains Natural Gas Co.'s billing units from MCF's to DK's. However, it was discovered that the conversion calculation contained the wrong atmospheric pressure for Wahpeton, ND.

On March 19, 2014, Great Plains filed a corrected conversion factor using a more accurate atmospheric pressure for the city of Wahpeton.

Staff has reviewed the revised filing and tariff changes noting no exceptions other than the base cost of demand and commodity charges were not converted from an MCF basis to a DK basis in Great Plains' cost of gas tariff. Great Plains will refile the tariff sheet to correct the oversight prior to the commission's next meeting. The commission received no requests to intervene or hold a hearing.

After said changes are made, staff recommends approval of the tariff revisions. Staff will put the matter on the April 23 meeting for approval and make sure the corrected tariffs are received before then.
