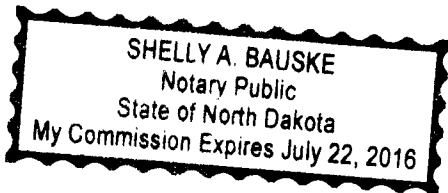

TO DISCONTINUE BUSINESS**

July 30, 2013


Farmers Elevator Co. of Honeyford operates a licensed public grain warehouse at Gilby, North Dakota, under license number 691 issued by the Public Service Commission under the provisions of North Dakota Century Code Chapter 60-02. The Commission received a request to discontinue business for this facility. The warehouse is empty and there are no outstanding storage obligations.

Order

The Commission orders:

1. Warehouse license number 691 issued to Farmers Elevator Co. of Honeyford is cancelled effective June 27, 2013 and Farmers Elevator Co. of Honeyford shall remit license number 691 to the Commission; and
2. Business at Gilby, North Dakota, is discontinued effective June 27, 2013 and Farmers Elevator Co. of Honeyford shall not conduct any further business under license number 691.
