Re: Waiver of Months to Exhaust/Utilization Threshold Requirement – Fargo Rate Center

Dear Mr. Nitschke:

By this letter, Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink (“CenturyLink”) is requesting a waiver of the utilization threshold and Months-to-Exhaust (MTE) requirements outlined in FCC’s Numbering Resource Optimization Orders, FCC 00-429 and FCC 01-362 released in CC Docket No 99-200, which would allow PA/Neustar, the Number Pooling Administrator, to assign a 1,000 block (1K Block) to CenturyLink to fulfill a specific customer request.

The request is for 1,000 numbers in the 701 NPA, Fargo Rate Center to meet the needs of CenturyLink to provide additional service to meet a specific customer request. The customer is requesting a Block in any NXX as long as the block does not start with zero (0), 1, 6, 7 or 8. Currently, the Fargo Rate Center pool has 1K blocks that will fit into our customer’s dialing plan, so a new NXX Code does not need to be opened. CenturyLink does not have a number Block in inventory that will satisfy the customer’s request.

In order to satisfy the customer request, CenturyLink submitted a request for a Block of numbers (1,000 numbers) to PA/Neustar on August 15, 2013. The request was immediately denied because CenturyLink’s current Rate Center Month to Exhaust (MTE) and Rate Center Utilization did not meet the requirements. In order for the request to be approved, CenturyLink will require a waiver of the current utilization threshold and MTE requirement for this application. The original request and subsequent denial have been provided with this letter as Attachment A. Attachment B is the customer letter and Attachment C is an email from the customer indicating its ability to use either 701-715-9 or 701-781-9 number blocks.

The customer has indicated that the 701-715-9 Block can be used in its internal dialing plan and would like this block to be assigned to this request. This Block is available in the Fargo Rate Center pool.

The FCC allows for a waiver of the rules when there is demonstrated need to service a specific customer request. The waiver process is specifically addressed in the FCC Third Report and Order ("Order") as the "safety valve" process (See FCC 01-362, paras. 57-66), which went into effect on March 14, 2002. The Order delegates the authority to hear claims for waivers to the state commissioners and recommends that state commissions act expeditiously. The Order proposes that state commissions review a waiver within 10 business days. (See Paras. 61, 66). CenturyLink respectfully requests that the Commission approve the request for a waiver of utilization threshold requirements and direct PA/Neustar to assign a Block (1,000 numbers) in the Fargo Rate Center in the 701 NPA as outlined in this request to allow us to meet this specific customer request.
