**PETITION FOR WAIVER OF CENTRAL OFFICE CODE  
ASSIGNMENT GUIDELINES**

INTRODUCTION

In accordance with Federal Communications Commission rules found at 47 C.F.R. 52.15(g)(3)(iv) and pursuant to Central Office Code (NXX) Assignment Guidelines published by the Industry Numbering Committee Integra Telecom of North Dakota, Inc. (“Integra”) respectfully requests a waiver of the numbering resource guidelines in order to secure a new Local Routing Number (“LRN”) for assignment to the Company’s new switch which will serve the Fargo, North Dakota rate center.

SUPPORT FOR REQUEST

Central Office Code (NXX) Assignment Guidelines, Section 4.1.3 state that a service provider requesting a LRN for a rate center in which the service provider already has numbering resources must meet certain months-to-exhaust and utilization requirements. Although Integra has not yet reached the months-to-exhaust and utilization criteria for the assignment of a new LRN for the Fargo rate center, it nonetheless requires a new LRN in order to deploy its new switch to serve this rate center.

Attachment A to this Petition is the Pooling Administrator’s response to Integra’s request for the Fargo rate center LRN, including the percent utilization and months-to-exhaust detail.

Federal Communications Commission Rule 47 C.F.R.(g)(3)(iv) states in part: “[t]he carrier may challenge the NANPA’s decision to the appropriate state regulatory commission. The state commission may affirm or overturn the NANPA’s decision to withhold numbering resources from the carrier based on its determination of compliance with the reporting and numbering resource application requirements herein.”

#### CONCLUSION

Integra respectfully requests that the North Dakota Public Service Commission expeditiously grant its petition and direct the Pooling Administrator, Nuestar, to release additional numbering resources to the Company, so that it may commence the operation of its new switch to serve the Fargo, North Dakota rate center.

**Instructions for filling out each Section of the Part 1A form:**

Section 1.1 Contact information requires that Service Providers supply under "Block Applicant" the company name, company headquarters address, a contact within the company, an address where the contact person may be reached, in addition to the correct phone, fax, and e-mail address. The Pooling Administrator section also requires the Service Provider to fill in the Pooling Administrator's name, address, phone, fax and e-mail.

Section 1.2 Service Providers who need a thousands-block assignment or for an Location Routing Number (LRN) are required to fill in this section. If needed for an LRN, a CO Code Application needs to also be submitted to the PA. The Service Provider should supply the Numbering Plan Area (NPA); the Local Access Transport Area (LATA), which is a three-digit number that can be found in the Telcordia™ LERG™ Routing Guide. The Operating Company Number (OCN) assigned to the service provider and the OCN its parent company. An OCN is a four-character alphanumeric assigned by Telcordia™ Routing Administration (TRA). In addition, the number of thousands-blocks requested should be supplied. The Switch Identification as well as the city or wire center name, rate center, rate center sub zone, homing tandem and CLLI™ tandem of the facilities based provider<sup>xi</sup>. Explanations of these terms may be found in the footnotes.

Section 1.3 The date the Service Provider completes the application should be entered in this section, as well as the Effective Date of the requested thousands-block.

Section 1.4 Service Providers should indicate their type, e.g., local exchange carrier, competitive local exchange carrier, interexchange carrier, CMRS. The also indicate the primary type of business in which the numbering resource is to be used. Service Providers also may indicate their preference for a particular thousands-block, e.g., 321-9XXX, or indicate any thousands-blocks that may be undesirable, e.g., 321-6XXX.

Section 1.5 Service Providers indicate the type of request. Initial requests are for first applications for thousands-blocks in a rate center, growth for additional thousands-blocks in a rate center in which the applicant already has numbering resources, and provide the required evidence as ordered by the FCC.
