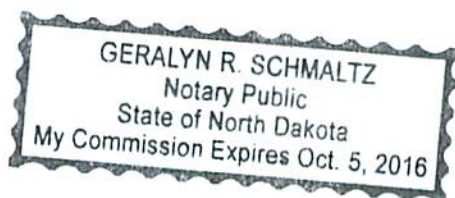

**NOTICE OF FILINGS AND NOTICE OF HEARING
October 23, 2013**

On October 4, 2013, Bakken Oil Express Pipeline, LLC (BOE) filed applications for a certificate of corridor compatibility and a route permit for the construction of a 38 mile 16-inch diameter crude oil pipeline in Dunn and Stark Counties, North Dakota, as shown on the attached map.

Also on October 4, 2013, BOE filed an application for waivers of procedures and time schedules established under North Dakota Century Code Chapter 49-22-07.2 and North Dakota Administrative Code Chapter 69-06-06 including:

- Procedures that require separate filings of applications for a certificate of corridor compatibility and a route permit,
- Procedures that require separate notices of such applications, and
- Procedures that require separate hearings on such applications.

A public hearing will be held on **December 9, 2013 at 9:00 A.M. MDT** (10:00 a.m. CDT) at the **Killdeer City Hall**, 165 Railroad Street SE, Killdeer, North Dakota 58640.

The issues to be considered in the application for waiver of procedures and time schedules include:

1. Are the proposed facilities of such length, design, location, or purpose that they will produce minimal adverse effects and that adherence to applicable procedures and time schedules may be waived?
2. Is it appropriate for the Commission to waive any procedures and time schedules as requested in the application?


The issues to be considered in the applications for certificate of corridor compatibility and route permit include:

1. Will the location, construction and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?

2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?

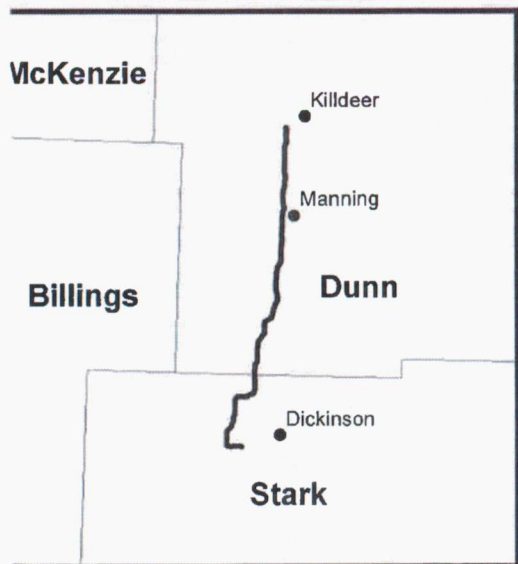
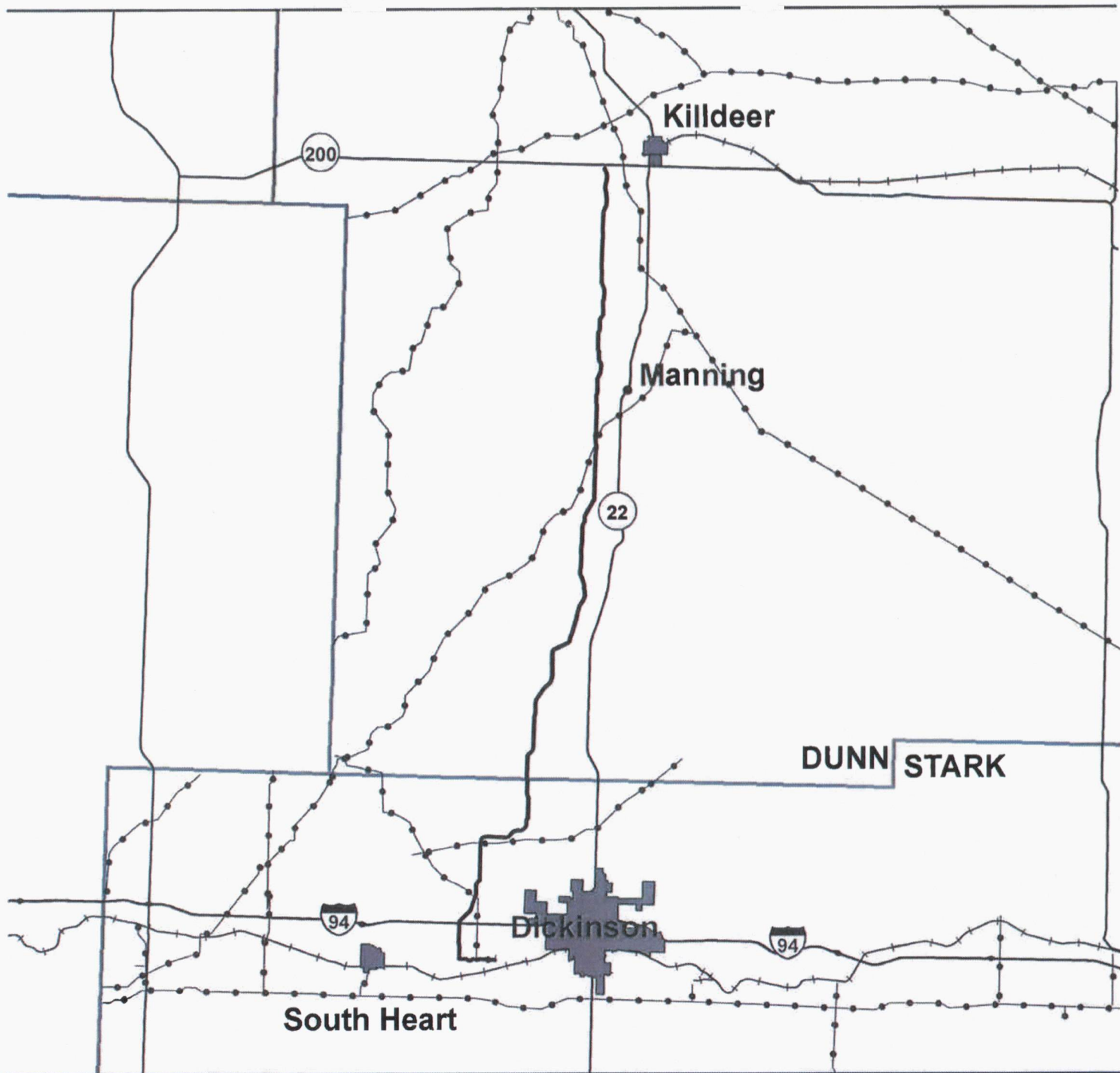

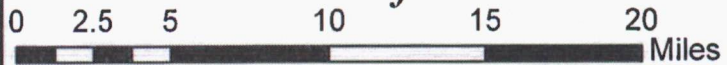
