RE: Enbridge's Sandpiper Project proposed pipeline location

This letter is to inform the Public Service Commission that Enbridge's proposed pipeline known as the Sandpiper Project is within 500 feet of my rural residence located in SW1/4 SW ¼, Sect. 29, Twp 156, Rg 92W Mountrail County. I have refused to sign a waiver that would allow the proposed pipeline to be placed within the 500 feet exclusion and avoidance area as per the ND Energy Conversion and Transmission Facility Siting Act 49-22-05.1

The construction of this proposed facility will adversely affect my ability to protect my residence and farmstead. The placement of this pipeline within 500 feet of my residence will destroy my windbreak tree rows and prevent me from establishing a windbreak at an appropriate distance around my farmstead. The tree rows were planted under an agreement with the USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service.

Recently, an Enbridge representative contacted me by phone and told me that the original offer has been withdrawn and the pipeline has been rerouted away from my property. Has the new route been filed with the Public Service Commission?
