Please consider the following as advocacy staff's response to Mr. Lindberg's request to change the hearing date. A continuance may be granted when good cause is shown. See N.D.Admin.C. 98-02-03-07. The Notice of Hearing was served on Mr. Lindberg on October 14, 2014. December 1 is the first date we have heard from Mr. Lindberg regarding a request to change the hearing date (or at all since the complaint and notice was served). Mr. Lindberg indicates he is scheduled to be in Grand Forks on Friday Dec. 5 for a business insurance meeting that cannot be changed. It is not indicated if this was scheduled before or after the notice of hearing was served upon him. It is not indicated why a continuance wasn't requested sooner than four days prior to the hearing. Advocacy staff is prepared for the hearing, having arranged the attendance of two witnesses from out of town, pre-filing exhibits, and undertaking all of the other steps necessary to proceed with the hearing as scheduled. Advocacy staff resists the request for a continuance and requests the hearing remain as scheduled.
