According to North Dakota Administrative Code Section 69-10-01-04.1, a variance permit granted by the commission is a temporary variance permit and does not become permanent until sufficient time to conclude inspection and testing (usually two years) has elapsed.

Shortly before expiration of the temporary variance permit, your case will be reviewed and a decision related to issuing a permanent variance permit will be made.
