Per the Nationwide Permit No.51, Land-Based Renewable Energy Generation Facilities, See the attached compliance documentation satisfying General Condition 30, stating Sunflower Wind Project LLC. is required to submit project compliance certification within thirty (30) days of project completion. The project was completed on December 21, 2016 and the total permanently disturbed wetland area was 0.18 acres. As requested, we have executed two permits covering the .11 and .19 acres of disturbance credits the project purchased from Ducks Unlimited. It is our understanding that the attached completes our permit obligations and Ducks Unlimited will restore/create .30 acres of wetland habitat.
