Status update

Dear Mr. Fahn:

As requested in your August 10, 2021 Notice and Request for Status Updates, Sunflower Wind Project, LLC (“Sunflower”) provides this monthly update regarding the status of its compliance with NDCC Section 49-22-16.4(3) for the Sunflower Wind Farm (“Project”).

As noted in our prior letters, Sunflower has been diligently working to implement a reliable light-mitigating system at the Project. Based on the prior experience of Sunflower’s parent company, Onward Energy, Sunflower identified two options it believes would be best for the Project from a technical, reliability, cost, and effectiveness standpoint. However, at this point, those options remain subject to FAA review, which has led Sunflower to analyze other available options.

Sunflower will provide a more complete update regarding its efforts to comply with the light-mitigating technology requirement in an extension request, which Sunflower plans to file next week.
