**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING**

**March 26, 2014**

On March 14, 2014, Northern States Power Company (NSP) filed an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to add a transformer to NSP's Prairie Substation in Grand Forks and extend 230 kV electric transmission line from that substation a distance of approximately 1,100 feet to interconnect with Minnkota Power Cooperative's Prairie Substation.

The issues to be considered in this matter are:

1. Whether public convenience and necessity will be served by construction and operation of the facilities.
2. Whether each of the applicants is fit, willing, and able to provide service.

Those interested are invited to comment on the applications in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceedings and the reasons for requesting a hearing. Comments and requests for hearing must be received by **April 30, 2014**. If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
