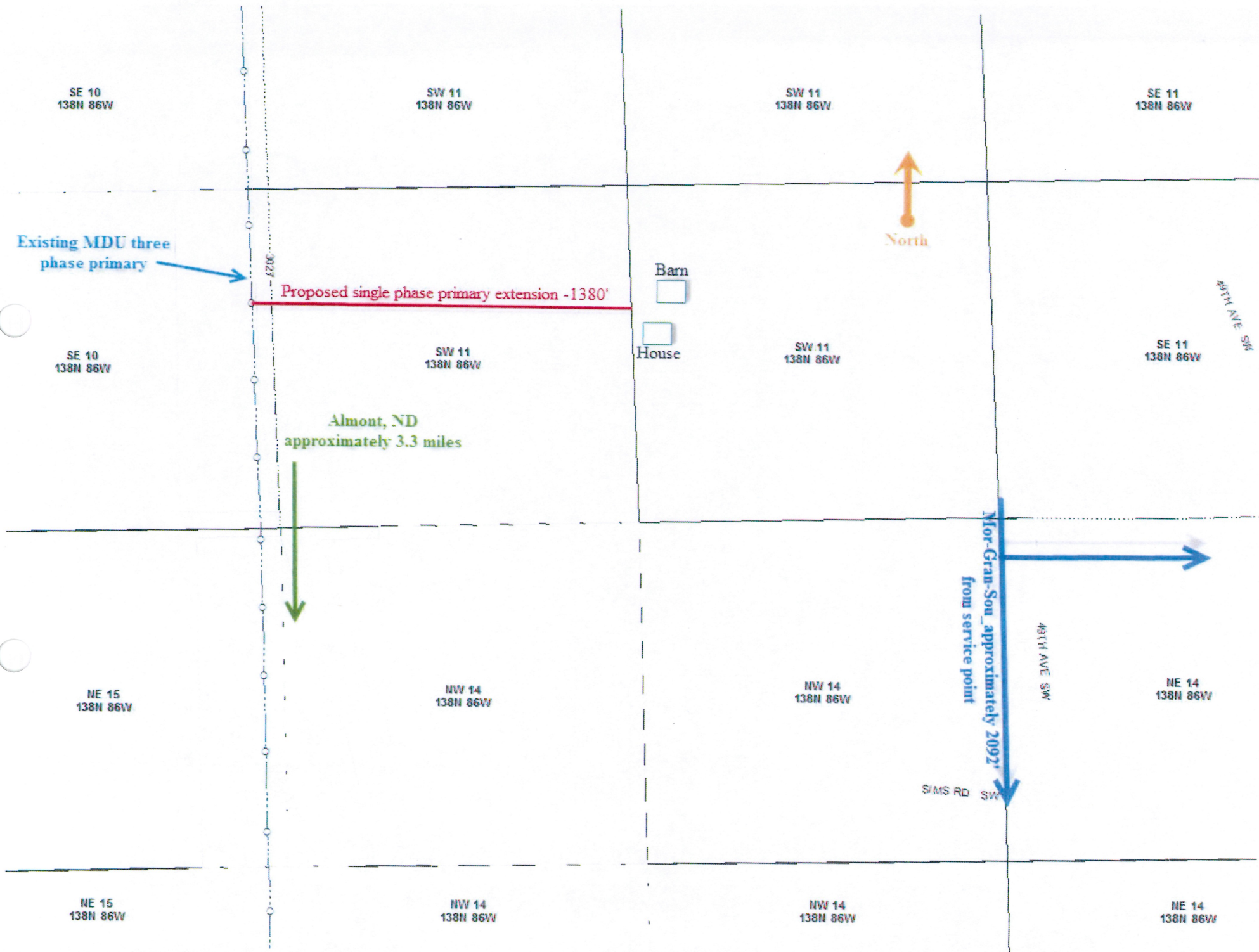

 Install overhead single phase primary from MDU's three phase overhead primary on west side of Highway 86, north of Almont, ND, heading east across Highway 86 approximately 1380' to feed a single phase overhead transformer for residential use.
 Total project to cost approximately \$17,751. A two year allowance based on \$180.00 per month will be granted to the customer. The customer, Scott Hoovestol, will contribute \$13,431.00 prior to construction.

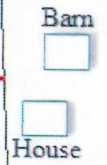
