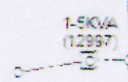
← Closest point to Mor-Gran-Sou approximately 3030' to the west

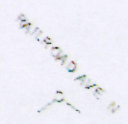

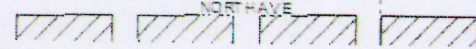
