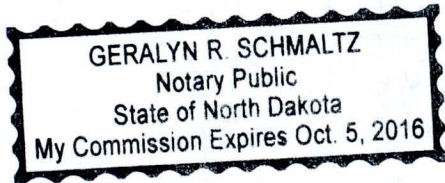

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING
