On April 21, 2014, ONEOK Rockies Midstream, L.L.C., filed an application for a certificate of site compatibility for the proposed Lonesome Creek Gas Plant, to be located approximately 13 miles southwest of Watford City in McKenzie County, North Dakota, as shown on the attached map. The Commission finds the application is complete.

A public hearing on the application is scheduled for **June 18, 2014, at 10:00 a.m. CDT, at Teddy's Residential Suites, 113 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE, Watford City, North Dakota 58854.**

The issues to be considered are:

1. Will the location, construction and operation of the proposed facility produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Is the proposed facility compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility location minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?

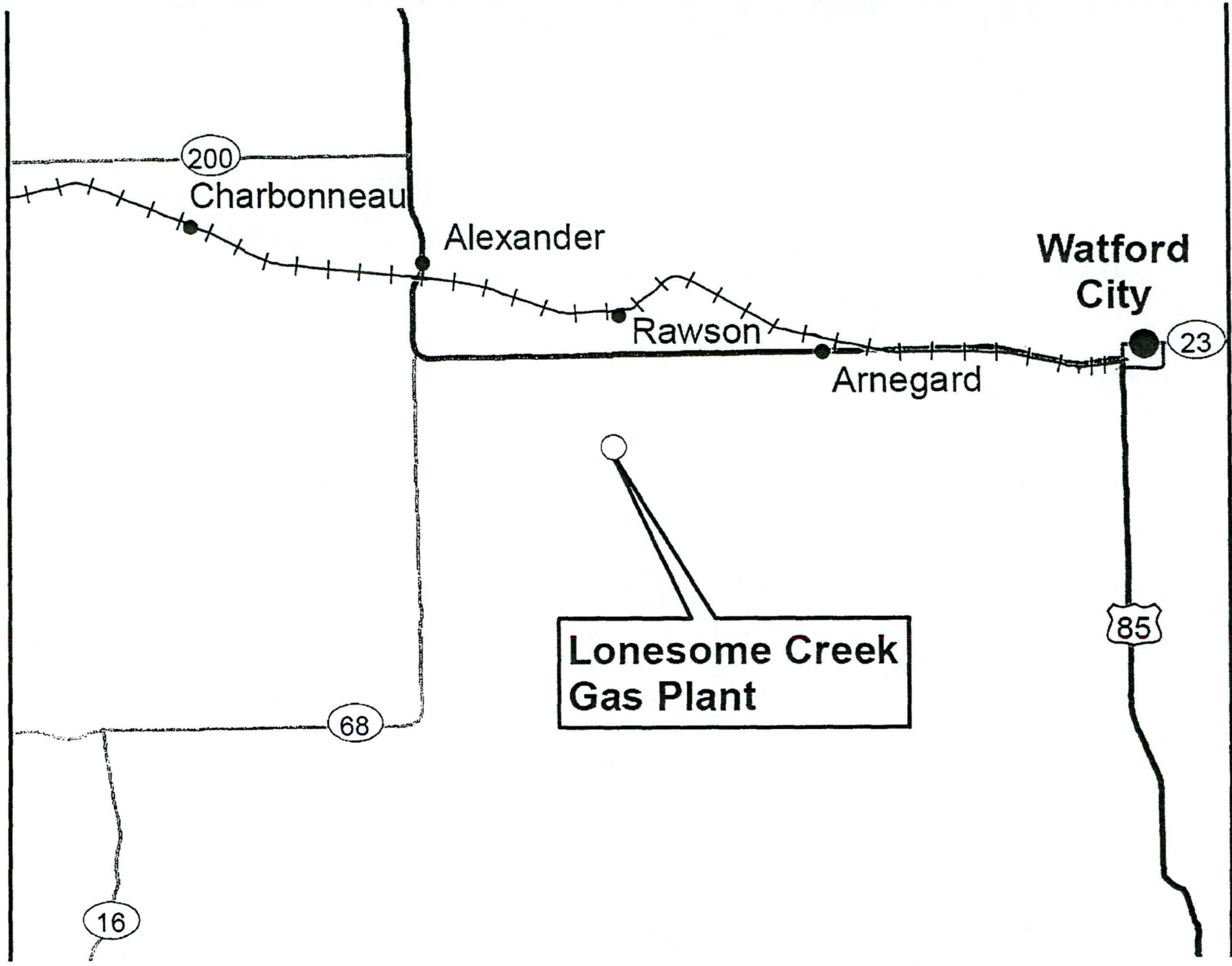
