

Roll call. See above.

Ms. Prescott indicated that construction can begin once the PSC receives these minutes, Ms. Prescott receives an email notification of the date that Meadowlark will begin construction, and a contact for landowner complaints is filed in the docket.

Ms. Davis reminded the group that this is a conversion project and involves very little new construction.

Julie read each certification item. The following items were discussed:

Item 17: Meadowlark confirmed that it has complied with this item for the existing pipeline.

Item 28: Meadowlark agrees to file contact information for landowner complaints in the docket.

Item 31: Meadowlark stated that it has already complied with this provision through filings in the docket. Meadowlark will send Mr. Gaffrey a copy of the GIS shape files of the route for purposes of his inspection.

Mr. Blikre confirmed that Meadowlark did not remove any trees or shrubs during construction, and tree and shrub mitigation measures will not apply

Ms. Davis agreed to send Ms. Prescott an email with Meadowlark's construction start date for conversion facilities.
