
We received your letter dated May 21, 2014 regarding the complaint filed by Larry Novak. The following are responses to the lettered items contained therein, using the same nomenclature:

- a) We are aware of the situation that Mr. Novak described and have been speaking with him about his concerns. However, we are only the right-of-way agents for this project. We have been passing on his concerns to our clients, Hiland Partners and Renegade Gas Services, the pipeline company and the inspection company.
