This case will not make the July 10th agenda.

I have a couple questions about the application before we can mark it as completed.

1 – Have you consulted with the County and Cities in the area on their future plans for expansion? Could this pipeline have any impact on those plans?

2 – Have you submitted studies to any other agencies listed in 69-06-01-05?

Other follow-up questions:

1 – 57% of the pipeline is noted as co-located with other utilities. What are the other utilities it would be co-located with, and how many crossing of those utilities will there be?

2 – How do you intend to cross the multiple wetlands and waterways in the preferred route? Directional boring, etc.?

3 – The study area for the natural and cultural studies mentions that it is 250ft wide. Is the center of that corridor the centerline of the pipe, or something else? In the enclosed maps the width of the study area seems to vary along the length of the route.

Please respond to these questions both via email and in writing (hardcopy) so that it may be noted for the official file.
