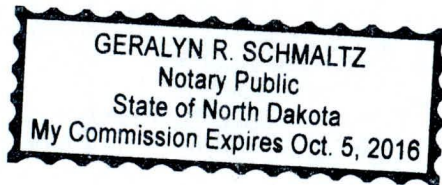

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

On June 18, 2014, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co., an electric public utility, filed an application under Chapter 49-03, N.D.C.C. to extend service to Tim Wickenheiser at a location in Emmons County, North Dakota.
