
Submitted with the application was a statement by Northern Plains Cooperative that the customer desires electric service to be provided by the applicant. Service is to be provided at a point located in:

Any interested party has the right to file written objection, based on the issue of public convenience and necessity, with the Commission by **September 21, 2014**, and the matter will then be set for hearing. If no objections are received by that date, the application may be granted as requested.
