Dear Mr. Fahn:

On January 26, 2015, the North Dakota Public Service Commission (the "Commission") issued Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 162 and Route Permit No. 174 to Targa Badlands LLC (Targa) in Case No. PU-14-625 authorizing the conversion from gathering to transmission service of an 8-inch crude oil gathering pipeline and associated facilities in Mountrail County, North Dakota. The Certification Relating to Ordering Provisions issued in this case requires Targa to provide certain notices and information to the Commission. With this letter, Targa is providing the notices and information required by Conditions 4, 5 and 29 of the Ordering Provisions.

Condition 4 – Company certifies that it has obtained all other necessary licenses and permits, and shall provide copies of all licenses and permits to the Commission.

Targa provided copies of all necessary licenses and permits issued by governmental agencies in Appendix D and Appendix G of its Combined Corridor Compatibility and Route Permit Application filed in the above referenced case on July 18, 2014. Targa has enclosed copies of these two Appendixes with this letter for the Commission's convenience.

Condition 5 – Company agrees to inform the Commission and the Commission's third-party construction inspector immediately prior to the Company initiating operation of the facility as a transmission facility.

Targa will initiate operation of the pipeline as a transmission facility the week of February 9, 2015. Targa will notify the Commission's third-party construction inspector promptly after the Commission selects and retains an inspector.

Condition 29 – Company understands and agrees that it will file with the commission the name and phone number of the current company representative who is responsible for receiving and resolving landowner issues for the transmission facility. The company will update this information whenever there is a change to the current company representative for the life of all easements for the transmission facility.
