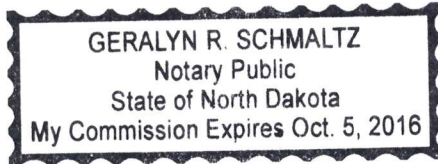

September 17, 2014


On July 17, 2014, Northern States Power Company filed a petition to modify its Interruptible Service tariffs. The modifications are intended to reduce the frequency of customers served under this tariff from taking unauthorized natural gas during a curtailment period.

The issue to be considered in this proceeding is whether the proposed tariff modifications are reasonable and prudent.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by November 1, 2014.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
