Hi Kent,

I'm trying to finish up this damage complaint, but need a few more pieces of information from you.

1. Has Rock Solid Excavating reimbursed WBI for the damages?

No, we have not received payment for the damages from Rock Solid Excavating. The invoice was dated 10/13/14 and payment was due 11/14/14.

2. What size was the pipe that was damaged, and how many customers would have been without service if you had to shut it down to make the repair?

The pipe damaged was 12" pipe. It is difficult to estimate how many customers could have been lost. For one of the worst case scenarios, service to the city of Williston could have been lost.

3. How long did the repair take to complete?

I don't have the time that the actual repair took to install/complete, but WBI has a total of 57 man hours accumulated for the repair.
