



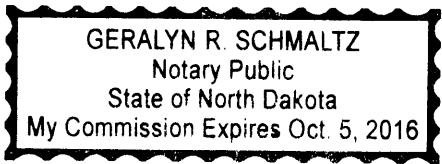

ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO DISCONTINUE BUSINESS


Order
