**NOTICE OF FILING AND NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING**

**October 8, 2014**

On July 31, 2014, Otter Tail Power Company filed an application for revisions to its Energy Adjustment Rider tariff to include recovery of costs for 1) purchased emission allowances that may be needed to comply with the federal Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) Cross-State Air Pollution Rule (CSAPR); and 2) reagent expenses associated with emission controls being installed to comply with the EPA's Mercury and Air Toxics Standards (MATS) rules. The tariff revisions would increase the cost of electric service by \$.00098 per kWh or 74 cents per month for a customer using 750 kWh's per month.

The issues to be considered in this proceeding are:

1. Whether the proposed tariff changes are reasonable, and
2. Whether the tariff changes should be approved.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by November 12, 2014.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
