**NOTICE OF HEARING**

**July 29, 2015**

On December 17, 2014, the Commission issued Certificate of Site Compatibility No. 41 to Antelope Hills Wind Project, LLC designating a site for construction of a 172 MW Antelope Hills Wind Energy Project consisting of up to 85 wind turbine generators and associated facilities in Mercer County, North Dakota.

On July 23, 2015, Antelope Hills filed an amendment application requesting modifications to the approved turbine site plan within the designated project area shown on the attached map. The Commission finds the amendment application complete.

A Public Hearing on the amendment application is scheduled to begin **September 4, 2015 at 9:00 a.m. CDT** at the Council Chambers, 120 N Central Avenue, Beulah, North Dakota 58523. The issues to be considered are:

1. Will the location, construction, and operation of the proposed amended facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Are the proposed amended facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed amended facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?

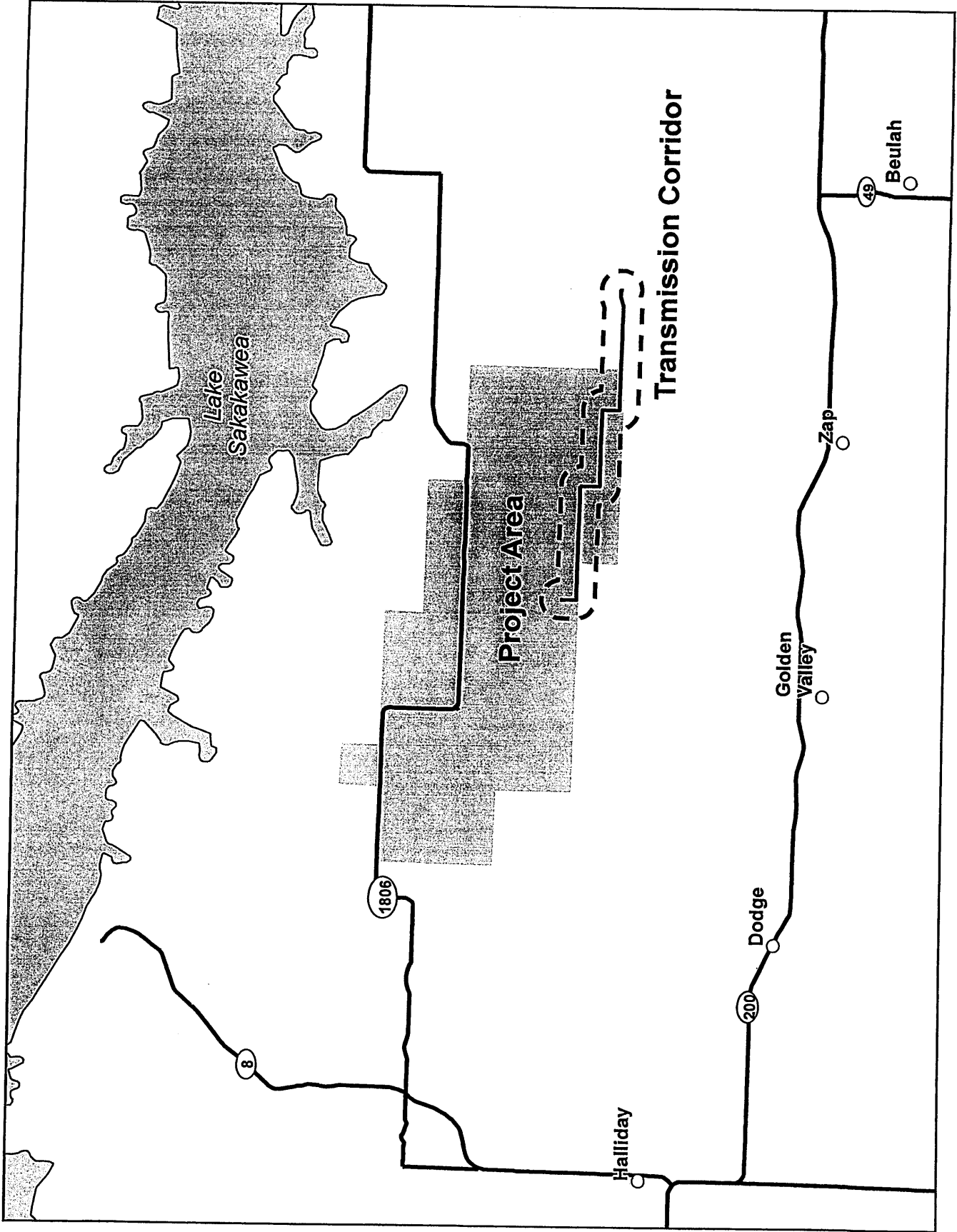
