NOTICE OF FILINGS AND NOTICE OF HEARING

November 6, 2014

On August 15, 2014, Caliber Midstream Partners, L.P. (Caliber) filed an application for a certificate of corridor compatibility and an application for a route permit concerning a 4.4-mile, 6-inch natural gas liquids pipeline and associated facilities in McKenzie County, North Dakota, as shown on the attached map.

Also on August 15, 2014, Caliber filed an application for waivers of procedures and time schedules established under North Dakota Century Code sections 49-22-07.2, 49-22-08, 49-22-08.1, 49-22-13, and North Dakota Administrative Code section 69-06-01-02, requiring separate filings, separate notices, and separate hearings on such applications.

The Commission finds the applications are complete.

A public hearing on the applications is scheduled for **January 13, 2015, at 9:00 a.m. Central Time, at Teddy's Residential Suites, 113 9th Avenue SE, Watford City, North Dakota 58854.**

The issues to be considered in the application for waiver of procedures and time schedules include:

1. Are the proposed facilities of such length, design, location, or purpose that they will produce minimal adverse effects and that adherence to applicable procedures and time schedules may be waived?
2. Is it appropriate for the Commission to waive any procedures and time schedules as requested in the application?

The issues to be considered in the applications for a certificate of corridor compatibility and a route permit include:

1. Will the location and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?

2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?

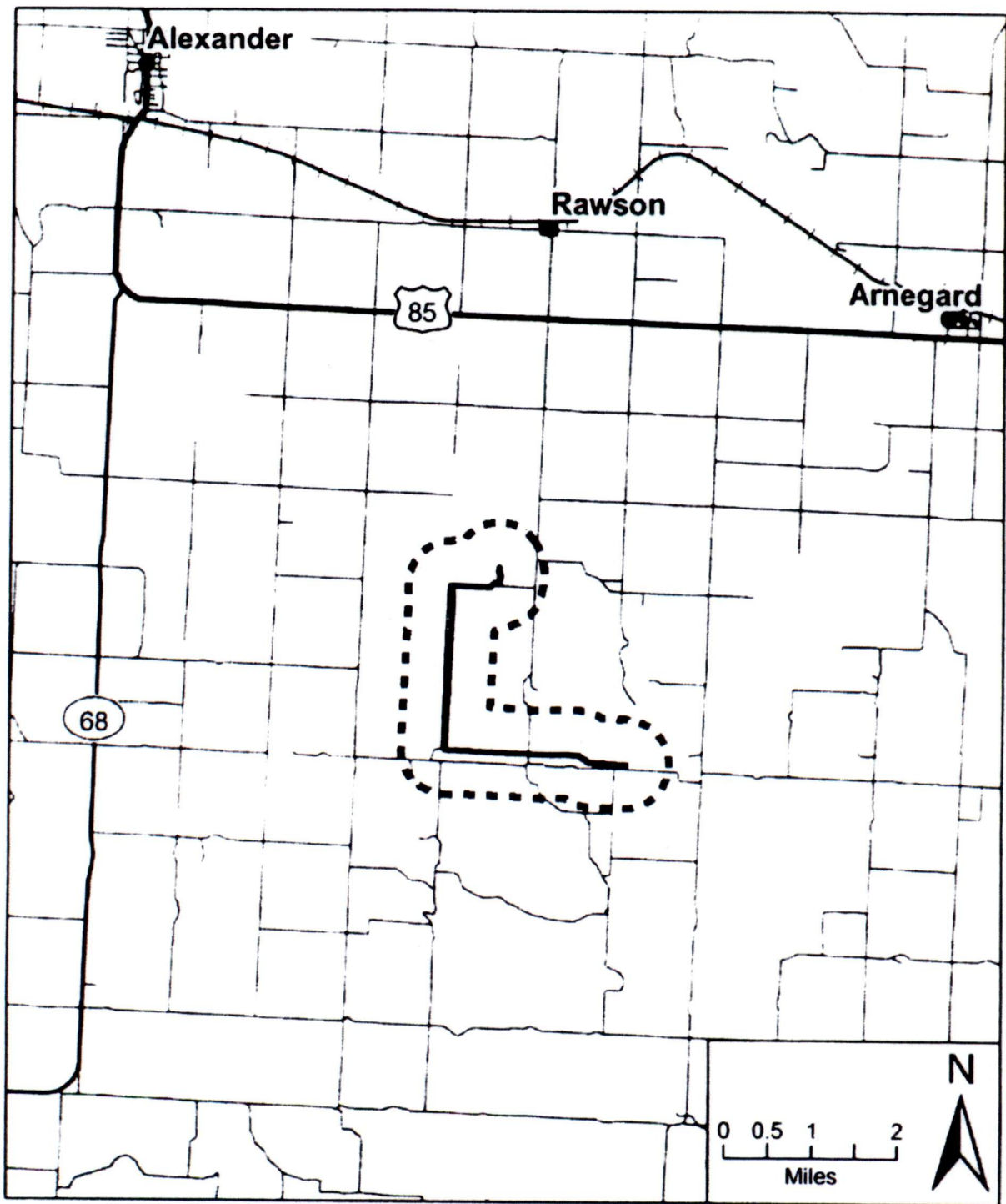
