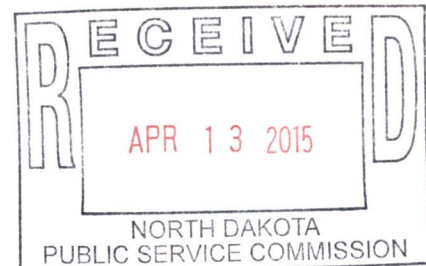

**Motion for an Amendment of the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order
Issuing Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and Route Permit**

Caliber Midstream Partners, L.P. (“Caliber”), hereby moves the North Dakota Public Service Commission (“Commission”) for an amendment of the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order issued in the above-captioned matter for Caliber’s 4.4 mile, 6-inch steel natural gas liquids pipeline and associated facilities (“Project”), located in McKenzie County, North Dakota.

In support of its motion, Caliber states as follows:

1.

On August 15, 2014, Caliber filed a consolidated application for a Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and Route Permit with the Commission for its proposed Project.

2.

On November 6, 2014, the Commission deemed the consolidated application complete and scheduled the matter for a hearing.

3.

On January 13, 2015, a public hearing on Caliber’s consolidated application was held before the Commission as scheduled. At the time of the public hearing, testimony was inadvertently given

as to the capacity of the Project. Reference was made to the capacity of the Project having a maximum design flow rate of 21,000 barrels per day, when in fact the Project will only have a maximum design flow rate of 2,100 barrels per day, as noted in the consolidated application.

4.

On April 8, 2015, the Commission issued its Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order (“Order”) with the incorrect maximum design flow rate, and issued Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 164 and Route Permit No. 176 to Caliber in accordance with the Order.

WHEREFORE, Caliber respectfully requests the following:

- a. In accordance with the correct information contained in the consolidated application, that Findings of Fact paragraph 6 be corrected to include the accurate design flow rate of 2,100 barrels per day for the Project;
- b. That the record be updated accordingly to correct any inadvertent testimony as to the design flow rate;
- c. That the Commission correct the dates in paragraph 4 of the Preliminary Statement to accurately reflect the date the consolidated application was deemed complete and the date of issuance of the Notice of Filings and Notice of Hearing to November 6, 2014, and in Order provision 5 to reflect the accurate date of filing of the Certification Relating to Order Provisions as March 31, 2015; and
- d. That the Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and Route Permit be updated in accordance with any amended order, and to correct the spelling of Caliber in the Certificate of Corridor Compatibility.




