Molly, I have about 10 of these coming your way over the next 6 weeks. (may be more), To help move these along, and not tie up everyone's time too long, we just need to agree on where primary will come from, if the primary will be overhead, or underground, and an approximate cost. If there is anything I can do on my part to make things less painful, let me know.

What is the voltage of the transmission line on the south side of hwy 50, and who is the operator?

I am working on the design for electrical service to a new proposed site for Verizon Wireless called Appam, located just west of Appam. We would be establishing 200 amp single phase 240V service. Attached are a set of plans. I would like to determine if there are any costs to establish service at this location, and determine the primary and secondary design for this site.

It looks like you do not have a neutral on this line. Is that going to force an overhead service?
