



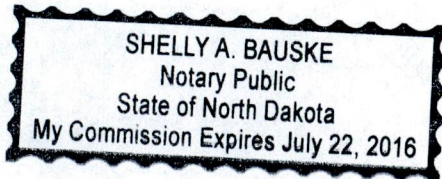

NOTICE OF FILING AND NOTICE OF HEARING

December 17, 2014

On October 23, 2014, ONEOK Rockies Midstream, L.L.C. (ONEOK) filed an application for a certificate of site compatibility (application) concerning a 400 million standard cubic foot per day gas processing plant to be located on approximately 160 acres in McKenzie County, North Dakota, as shown on the attached map.

The Commission finds the application is complete.

A public hearing on the application is scheduled for **February 9, 2015, at 9:00 a.m. Central Time, at Teddy's Residential Suites, 113 9th Avenue SE, Watford City, North Dakota 58854.**


The issues to be considered in the application are:

1. Will the location and operation of the proposed facility produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Is the proposed facility compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility location minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?
