

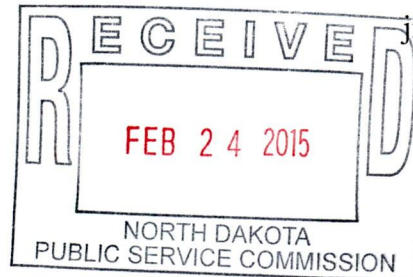


ONEOK Rockies Midstream, L.L.C. ("ONEOK"), applicant in the captioned matter, requests that the record be supplemented with this letter.

At the hearing of this matter on February 9, 2014, ONEOK presented testimony indicating that construction of the first train of the Demicks Lake Gas Processing Plant (the "Plant") would commence later this year upon receipt of necessary authorizations. Due to lower commodity prices, reduced producer drilling and the anticipated impact to natural gas volume growth, ONEOK is suspending capital expenditures for the Plant until such time as market conditions improve.

ONEOK appreciates the efforts of the Commission and its staff in expeditiously setting the hearing and requests that the Commission proceed with the entry of a final order and the issuance of a certificate of site compatibility in accordance with the evidence presented at the hearing. Doing so would ensure that ONEOK would be in position to quickly resume activity on the Plant when the economic environment improves and there is assurance of adequate demand for the services.
