
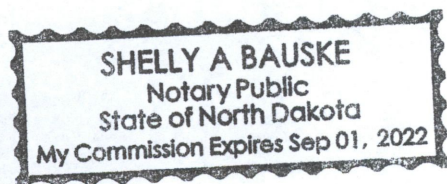

**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING**

**April 5, 2018**

On March 25, 2015, the Public Service Commission (Commission) issued its Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order (Order) designating a 160-acre site for ONEOK Rockies Midstream, L.L.C. (ONEOK) for the location of the Demicks Lake Gas Processing Plant in McKenzie County, North Dakota.

On March 26, 2018, as required by the Order, ONEOK informed the Commission of its plans to modify the energy conversion facility. ONEOK states the project continues to be located on the designated 160-acre site and the plant still consists of two cryogenic turboexpander processing units, with each unit capable of processing 200 million standard cubic feet per day of wellhead gas. ONEOK plans to rearrange the plant design and add thermal oxidizers, add an amine gas treating system, remove storage tanks, and include a natural gas liquids (NGL) tie-in to accommodate direct transfer of NGL to an NGL pipeline. ONEOK requests approval for the modifications.

On April 4, 2018, ONEOK filed a request to amend the Commission's Order to modify paragraph 30 of the Certification Relating to Order Provisions, incorporated by reference into the Order, to provide the Commission flexibility to approve facility modifications without requiring that a notice and opportunity for hearing be issued in instances where notice is not otherwise required by rule or statute.

The issues in the request for approval of plant modifications are:

1. Will the location and operation of the proposed facility produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Is the proposed facility compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility location minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?

The issues in the request to amend the Order are:

1. Will the Order as modified continue to result in minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?


2. Will the Order as modified continue to be compatible with ensuring environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the Order as modified continue to minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?

Comments and requests for a hearing must be received by **May 3, 2018**. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. If deemed appropriate, the commission can determine these matters without a hearing.
