### **Minutes:**

Roll call. See above.

Ms. Prescott reviewed the certification document item by item. The following items were further discussed:

Item 5: Ms. Prescott confirmed that an email is sufficient for notice of the estimated construction start date, and this applies for actually putting pipe in the ground, as opposed to only surveying.

Item 13: Meadowlark confirmed that it does not generally open cut roads, but if it needs to, it will get appropriate local permission and will notify Ms. Prescott.

Item 29: Meadowlark agrees to file contact information for landowner complaints in the docket.
