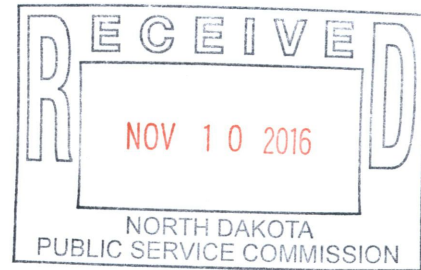

Dean R. Blikre, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. I am North Dakota Construction Manager for Summit Midstream Partners, LLC and its subsidiary, Meadowlark Midstream Company, LLC ("Meadowlark"), and I submit this affidavit on behalf of Meadowlark in North Dakota Public Service Commission (the "Commission") Case No. PU-14-823.
2. I have personal knowledge of the issues addressed in this affidavit.
3. The Commission issued an order approving Meadowlark's application for a certificate of corridor compatibility and for a route permit for a 46-mile long, 10-inch diameter crude oil pipeline (the "Project") on May 13, 2015.
4. Construction on the Project was completed at the end of October, 2015.
5. No trees or shrubs were disturbed as a result of construction of the Project. When encountered, trees and shrubs were bored under, rather than disturbed.
