Commissioners:

I received a notification today from Kathy Moreno (HR representative for Dakota Access), who stated that an employee of Russel Group (ETP security contractor) was injured yesterday (12/6/16) and required off-site treatment when a vehicle door accidentally slammed shut on the individual's hand, due to the wind. Sixteen stitches were required but no bones were broken in the incident, which occurred on Spread 7 near Mandan. The individual was treated and returned to work.

Moreno indicated that the incident has also been reported to OSHA.

Per the Certification to Order Provisions attached to the Order in this case (provision #27, see below), Dakota Access is required to notify the Commission within five business days when an injury to any person occurs.

- 27. Company understands and agrees that it shall advise the Commission of any extraordinary events which take place at the site of the transmission facility, including injuries to any person, or the death of any threatened or endangered species on the site within five business days of such event.**
