**Subject:** Additional corrections to Revision No. 1 to Permit NACC-1302

Sarah,

In follow-up to our telephone conversation this morning, the following are the additional corrections that are needed to the application for Revision No. 1 to Permit NACC-1302 following Coyote Creek's June 3<sup>rd</sup> response to our second technical review letter. Staff has been already in contact with you regarding these items. Once these corrections are made, new DVD's showing the latest changes should be submitted as soon as possible:

1. Include an updated Monitoring Well Location Map, Section 2.3.4.2, that contains the updated monitoring well identifier CM15-01A for the proposed Knife River Alluvial Well in the NE1/4 of Section 14. (BEB)
2. Please provide the latest and correct version of Section 3.1.1.8, Reclamation Costs – (Incremental). The version sent to and reviewed by Bruce Johnson on June 8<sup>th</sup> should be the version that is included in the final application. This version also included appropriate changes to the narrative to explain why additional areas in Sections 24 and 25 were added to the revised bond increment. (BAJ & ZAB)
3. Please ensure that revised Section 3.2.4, North-South Haulroad, emailed to Reclamation staff on June 4<sup>th</sup> is included in the permit application DVD. Revised Section 3.2.4 submitted to Reclamation staff with June 4<sup>th</sup> email correspondence adequately addresses Items 23, 24 and 25 listed in our second technical review letter. The updated narrative apparently was not included on the June 3, 2015 version of the Revision No. 1 application. (WTG & GAW)

Also, please be reminded that you will be receiving a separate request to update the business entity and compliance information when the application for Revision No. 1 is ready for Commission action.
