The permit application you sent me states that "On February 13, 2013, CCMC submitted a request to the NDDH seeking clarification that the proposed mine and the existing Coyote Station power generation facility are separate stationary sources as it relates to the PSD rules, Section 112 of the Clean Air Act (CAA) for hazardous air pollutants (HAP) and Title V (Part 70) rules. In an April 11, 2013 letter to CCMC, NDDH confirmed that CCMC and Coyote Station are separate stationary sources."

Could you please also send me the February 13, 2013 letter from CCMC to NDDoH, as well as NDDoH's April 11, 2013 reply letter to CCMC?
