
Dear Mr. Schock:

On December 31, 2014, Targa Badlands LLC (“Targa”) filed with the North Dakota Public Service Commission (“Commission”) an Application for Certificate of Site Compatibility for the Little Missouri Gas Plant Expansion in McKenzie County, North Dakota, along with an Application for Waiver or Reduction of Procedures and Time Schedules.

After further review of the applicable statutes and rules for issuance of a Certificate of Site Compatibility, it appears all procedures and time schedules are satisfactory under the circumstances. As the Commission does not recognize any specific procedures or time schedules requiring waiver under the circumstances, Targa respectfully requests the Application for Waiver or Reduction of Procedure and Time Schedules be withdrawn.
