Dear Mr. Schock:

On February 10, 2015, we provided you with some supplemental information regarding the existing pipelines crossing Lake Sakakawea and Hess North Dakota Pipelines LLC's intentions for repurposing those pipelines. Since that time, Hess has re-evaluated the planned operations and has decided to modify those plans.

Specifically, in February we advised you that Hess planned to re-purpose Line #3 to a crude oil pipeline (Case No. PU-15-31) and Line #4 to a natural gas liquids line (Case No. PU-15-32) and use Line #5 as a spare, or loop, natural gas pipeline. Hess still intends to utilize Line #4 as an NGL line, but plans to utilize Line #5 as a crude oil pipeline. Line #3 will be used as a spare natural gas pipeline.

In connection with this change in plans, Hess has obtained a revised Spill Risk Assessment and we are filing that document with Commission today. No other changes were required to the application in Case No. PU-15-31 as a result of this modification to Hess' planned operations.
