Tucker E. Gordon, being first duly sworn upon oath, states and alleges as follows:

1. I am a Project Engineer for Plains Pipeline, L.P. (“Plains”), which proposes to construct, own, and operate the Bison Pipeline Project (“Project”), the subject of the above-captioned matter.

2. I was advised as to perjury, placed under oath, and testified on behalf of Plains at the June 24, 2015 public hearing on Plains’s Application for a Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and Route Permit (“Application”) for the Project.

3. In this Affidavit, I understand that I am still under oath and I am providing sworn testimony as part of the public hearing record, as authorized by and on behalf of Plains.

4. At the June 24, 2015 public hearing on Plains’s Application, Plains requested that the North Dakota Public Service Commission (“Commission”) issue a Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and a Route Permit designating the Project corridor and route, as depicted in Hearing Exhibit No. 2.

5. During the public hearing on Plains’s Application, Plains was granted the opportunity to submit a late-filed exhibit discussing the past, present, and future of the Robinson

Lake Facility. Further, the Commission has requested information regarding why the Robinson Lake Facility was not included in the Application.

6. The original Robinson Lake Facility was constructed by a third party to supply the Robinson Lake to Stanley transmission pipeline facility (“Stanley Transmission Pipeline”).

7. Plains acquired the Robinson Lake Facility and the associated Stanley Transmission Pipeline in 2010. Plains acquired these facilities as constructed and in the condition maintained by the third party entity.

8. Because of increased production in the area served by the Robinson Lake Facility, Plains determined it was necessary to construct an additional tank at the Robinson Lake Facility. That tank will provide additional capacity for the Stanley Transmission Pipeline. As currently designed, oil gathered from oil and gas wells in the area will be transported to the Robinson Lake Facility and the new tank will operate as an “overflow facility” to the existing tank. The additional tank being constructed at the Robinson Lake Facility is located on property that is part of the Robinson Lake Facility and is owned by Plains. The new tank is located less than one (1) mile from the existing tank.


9. The Project was designed to provide another outlet for crude oil gathered at the Robinson Lake Facility to a rail loading facility at the Van Hook Rail Facility approximately ten (10) miles to the South of the Robinson Lake Facility.

10. While the Project will transport oil from the Robinson Lake Facility to the rail loading facility at the Van Hook Rail Facility, the Robinson Lake Facility can operate independently of the Project.

11. Based on the anticipated use of the new tank at the Robinson Lake Facility and the location of the new tank within one (1) mile of the previous tank and transmission pipeline


and facilities, the new tank being constructed at the Robinson Lake Facility is exempt from siting and was not included in the Application.
