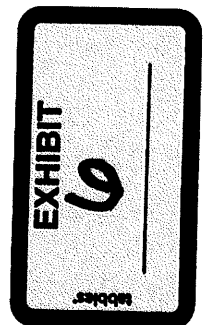

According to the Nass reports for this week Colorado is at 52%, and Nebraska is at 77%, Wyoming is at 30%, Montana is at 85%, Idaho is at 84%, Washington is at 96%, and North Dakota is at 62%, Michigan is at 61% harvested. With this new crop being wrapped up in the next couple of weeks the only thing holding up the movement of beans will be ongoing transportation issues with the railroad. Commodities like beans are being trumped over for oil and gas which have larger volumes that can be moved more frequently.
