## PU-15-97 Pre-Construction Conference Minutes

October 27, 2015 2:30 pm Central Time (Duration 19 minutes)

### Discussion

Pre-construction conference was held using the Bridger Pipeline LLC Conference Call in number. Roll call of participants showed the following people participating on the call.

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Julie Prescott confirmed that the participants on the call had a copy of the materials provided ahead of the meeting including the Certification Relating to Order Provisions as well as the Tree and Shrub Mitigation Specifications.

Ms. Prescott then led a review of both documents item by item. During the review she acknowledged that item 7 of the certification was being satisfied by the teleconference in progress and that these minutes would be the evidence of the meeting on the docket. Ms. Prescott also called special attention to item 9 of the certification pertaining to notice of construction and item 24 with regard to providing a name and number of a company representative to receive and address any landowner issues. Additionally the requirements in item 29 with regard to as-built information to be provided upon completion of construction were highlighted. Route adjustment requirements in items 31 through 37 were called out in the event a route revision becomes necessary.

There was short discussion regarding the pre-construction tree and shrub count inventories. Karine Becker from Keitu reported that the inventory had been completed and it is anticipated that no trees will need to be removed and that the post-construction inventory will verify how many, if any, are impacted. Ms. Prescott then reviewed the Tree and Shrub Mitigation Specifications with the group.

Kevin Magstadt, Julie Prescott and Ken Dockweiler discussed the need to provide gis information to Kevin for use in Wenck and Associates oversight of the project. Confidentiality of the data was discussed and Kevin and Ken committed to work together to share the data needed in a confidential fashion.

The attendees were polled for any additional questions and none were voiced.
