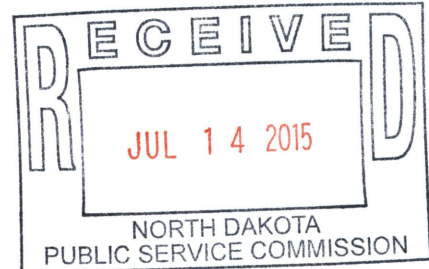


**RESPONSE TO PETITION TO
INTERVENE**

On May 18, 2015, the Laborers District Council of Minnesota and North Dakota (“Laborers Union”) filed a Petition to Intervene in the above-matter in connection with the Application of Sacagawea Pipeline Company, LLC (“Sacagawea”) for a Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and Route Permit for a 16-inch crude oil pipeline, approximately 70 miles in length, known as the Sacagawea Pipeline Project to be located in McKenzie and Mountrail Counties, North Dakota (the “Project”). *See* Docket No. 8. The Laborers Union seeks intervention pursuant to North Dakota Administrative Code § 69-02-02-05 as a party to this action.

As discussed in the Petition to Intervene, the Laborers Union seeks intervention in support of the Project proposed by Sacagawea. *See id.* at 2. At this time, the justification of the Laborers Union for intervention appears to align with the goals of Sacagawea and of the Project. Accordingly, Sacagawea has no objection to the intervention of the Laborers Union as a party to this action pursuant to North Dakota Administrative Code § 69-02-02-05.
