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Sacagawea Pipeline Company, LLC – Sacagawea Pipeline Project, Reroute 2

A proposed Sacagawea Pipeline Project reroute (Reroute 2) was surveyed on March, 23, 2016 in Section 22 T152N, R92W. The Supplemental Survey completed in this area was approximately 9 acres and is located near the city of New Town, North Dakota.

Keitu Engineers & Consultants, Inc. (Keitu) conducted a natural resources field survey in order to identify exclusion and avoidance areas as specified in the North Dakota Administrative Code 69-06-08-02 for the proposed Reroute 2. When Keitu conducts natural resources field surveys a concurrent threatened and endangered species survey and habitat assessment; a tree, sapling and shrub survey, and a noxious weed survey is completed.

During this field survey, Keitu did not identify any exclusion and avoidance areas. Although no exclusion or avoidance areas were identified, an estimated area approximately 900 square foot of Canada thistle (*Cirsium arvense*) was identified in the proposed Reroute 2 corridor. The border of this area was flagged to assist with future identification. According to the North Dakota Century Code Chapter 63-01.1 and the North Dakota Department of Agriculture, Canada thistle is recognized as a noxious weed.

Sacagawea Pipeline Company, LLC has identified in the Sacagawea Pipeline Project – Construction, Mitigation, and Reclamation Plan proper procedures for noxious weed control. This plan outlines cleaning procedures for equipment, pre-construction treatments, post-construction treatments, and addresses weed control during reclamation.
