



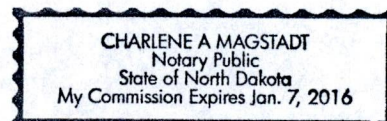

**NOTICE OF FILING AND NOTICE OF HEARING
MAY 13, 2015**

On March 20, 2015, Rolette Power Development, LLC (Rolette Power) filed: an application for a certificate of site compatibility to construct a 100 MW Rolette Wind Power Project consisting of up to 59 wind turbine generators and associated facilities in Rolette County, North Dakota. Rolette Power's proposed project area is shown on the attached map.

The Commission finds the application is complete conditioned upon filing final wind turbine locations at least ten days before hearing.

A **Public Hearing** on the application is scheduled to begin **June 29, 2015**, at **9:30 a.m. CDT** at the Memorial Hall, 503 2nd Avenue, Rolette, North Dakota, 58366. The issues to be considered are:

1. Will the location, construction, and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?
