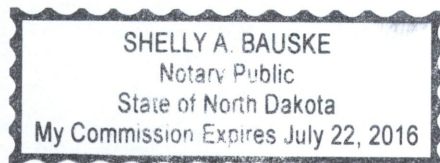

NOTICE OF HEARING

October 1, 2015

On March 20, 2015, Rolette Power Development, LLC (Rolette Power) filed an application for a certificate of site compatibility to construct a 100 MW Rolette Wind Power Project consisting of up to 59 wind turbine generators and associated facilities in Rolette County, North Dakota.

On May 13, 2015, the Commission deemed the application complete and issued a Notice of Filing and Notice of Hearing, scheduling a public hearing on the application to begin June 29, 2015, at 9:30 a.m. CDT at the Memorial Hall, 503 2nd Avenue, Rolette, North Dakota, 58366.


On June 29, 2015, pursuant to N.D.C.C. § 49-22-13, a public hearing was held as scheduled in Rolette County. Following the hearing an affidavit was received clarifying that active eagle nests had been identified in the vicinity of the project area.

Please take notice that a **Public Hearing** is scheduled to begin at **10:00 a.m. CDT on November 2, 2015** at the Memorial Hall, 503 2nd Avenue, Rolette, North Dakota, 58366. The issue to be considered is whether adverse effects on eagle health and safety will be managed and maintained to an acceptable minimum.
