NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

April 29, 2015

Otter Tail Power Company's (Otter Tail) Environmental Cost Recovery Rider tariff provides for an adjustment of rates to recover capital costs and operating expenses incurred to comply with federal mandates for environmental upgrades. The proposed rate adjustment to be effective for bills rendered on and after July 1, 2015, is applied as a percentage of base rates, as follows:

Existing Rate	7.531%
Proposed Rate	<u>9.193%</u>
Increase in Rate	<u>1.662%</u>

The issues to be considered in this proceeding are whether the proposed rate adjustment complies with the tariff and are reasonable and prudent.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by June 5, 2015.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
