We have reviewed correspondence and initial reporting of project documentation for: "Vantage West Spur Pipeline: A Class III Cultural Resource Inventory in Divide and Williams Counties, North Dakota," by Jennifer Thomas, Douglas Davidson, and Scott Wagers (Ethnoscience, February 2015). If consulted by a state agency, we would concur with a preliminary "*No Significant Sites Affected*" determination provided the project is of the nature stated and it takes place in the locations plotted, mapped, and described in the aforementioned project documentation. We concur that reported Isolated Finds (32WIX668-32WIX676) listed in Table 6.4 (p. 6-70) are not significant and also we concur with site significance recommendations provided in Table 7.1 (pp. 7.1-7.2).

Importantly, as stated on p. 7-4 and illustrated in Appendix A map coverage "Proposed Reroute -February 11, 2015," cultural resource inventory needs to be completed and reported on for those newly identified areas. Concurrence on findings and determinations of overall Vantage West Spur Pipeline project effect await the completion of inventory and review of addenda reporting documentation. Thank you for the opportunity to review this initial routing and also we look forward to forthcoming reporting documentation covering rerouted portions of the Vantage West Spur Pipeline mentioned above.
