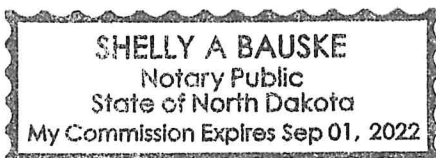

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**NOTICE OF CONSOLIDATED HEARING**

**September 22, 2021**

A **Consolidated Public Hearing** on the applications in the cases enumerated above will begin **Tuesday, November 2, 2021, at 8:30 a.m. central time, in the Commission Hearing Room, 12<sup>th</sup> Floor, State Capitol, Bismarck, North Dakota 58505.**

On September 10, 2021, Northern States Power Company, doing business as Xcel Energy, (NSP) filed with the Commission a request for an extension of time to equip the Border Winds energy conversion facility with a functioning light-mitigating technology system. Light-mitigating technology system means aircraft detection lighting system, lighting intensity dimming solution technology, or a comparable solution capable of reducing the impact of nighttime lighting while maintaining night conspicuity sufficient to assist aircraft in identifying and avoiding collision with the facilities. NSP requests an extension of the deadline from December 31, 2021, to June 30, 2022.

On September 10, 2021, NSP filed with the Commission a request for an extension of time to equip the Courtenay Wind energy conversion facility with a functioning light-mitigating technology system. NSP requests an extension of the deadline from December 31, 2021, to June 30, 2022.

The issue to be considered in these consolidated proceedings is whether an extension of time should be granted based on technical or economic feasibility considerations.
